Guided reef dives on the local Tulum Reefs are available for all levels of certified divers. Tulum waters are warm, clear, beautiful teeming with life. From amazing corals, to reef fish, sharks, turtle and even sealife / animals such as manatees that live in both salt and freshwater.

The Tulum Reef is close to the beach, easy to reach with our boats, no rough seas or sea sickness, they are shallow and easy to dive and snorkel . Our guides are all professional dive instructors that have safely guided / taught hundreds or thousands of divers in the local environment. Maximum allowed ratio of divers to guide is six to one.

Our typical day of guided reef diving includes two single tank dives in two different areas on the reef or can be combined with one or two cenote dives.
